What is The Leader in Me?

The Leader in Me aligns with Clear Creek ISD's strategic plan, most specifically to "ensure each student understands and is prepared to assume his or her role as a productive citizen."

Here's how:

The Leader in Me is a whole-school transformation model and process developed in partnership with educators that empowers students with the leadership and life skills they need to thrive in the 21st century. It is based on principles and practices of personal, interpersonal and organizational effectiveness, and upon the powerful premise that every child possesses unique strengths and has the ability to be a leader.

The Leader in Me helps students learn how to become self-reliant, take initiative, plan ahead, set and track goals, do their homework, prioritize their time, manage their emotions, be considerate of others, express their viewpoint persuasively, resolve conflicts, find creative solutions, value differences, and live a balanced life. With Stephen Covey's timeless 7 Habits of Highly Effective People, the process helps students develop the skills and self-confidence they need to lead their lives and succeed in school and beyond.

The Leader in Me Impact in Clear Creek ISD Today

The Leader in Me at the following two campuses was made possible through a Special Innovative Grant from the Clear Creek Education Foundation (CCEF) and support from each campus' PTA. By piloting this program, the trajectory of school academic performance has positively changed along with student achievement and students' success in life.

Falcon Pass Elementary School: Falcon Pass launched The Leader In Me program school-wide in 2016 and is currently at near full implementation. During year one of implementation, there were decreases in the number of students referred to the office and a decrease in those students who received one to two referrals for common misbehaviors. From an academic perspective, there were increases, some significant, in the number of students scoring in the range of "meets" or "masters" on STAAR tests in almost all grade levels and subject areas.

Armand Bayou Elementary School: Armand Bayou is completing its first year implementing The Leader in Me program. In this short amount of time, Armand Bayou has also realized positive data







trends including a decrease in counseling referrals for conflicts between students. This decrease, combined with observed data collected, indicates that students are using the skills they are learning to manage conflict resolution without adult intervention. There is also evidence of a growing culture of collective responsibility as indicated by the more than 200 students who have school-wide job responsibilities.

Clear Creek ISD's The Leader in Me Goal

Clear Creek ISD aims to develop leaders with 21st century skills. A comprehensive plan to incorporate *The Leader in Me* program throughout schools in the District will bring CCISD one step closer to this goal - and provide students with the tools to meet *their life goals*.

By 2022, Clear Creek ISD plans to fully incorporate *The Leader in Me* at **14 additional campuses** which include schools at the elementary, intermediate and high school levels. **This program goal impacts approximately 13,684 students.**


Membership Investment Breakdown

The Leader In Me whole-school transformation program incorporates quality tools and educational best practices. The following components are included in the program membership cost, which is calculated from of the number of teachers in a school.

- Franklin Covey IP License: Authorizes use of proprietary intellectual property and grants Leader In Me schools access to program resources
- Coaching and Professional Learning for All Staff: Includes a mix of on-site coaching, community coaching, and virtual training
- * Materials: Includes guides, videos, Leader In Me Online, and family and parent night resources

Program Funding Plan

- Clear Creek ISD: Clear Creek ISD has made the implementation of The Leader In Me program a priority and will invest 25% of the program cost through an allocation from the general fund.
